Our qualification programs are online which means you can enrol and participate from anywhere in Australia.

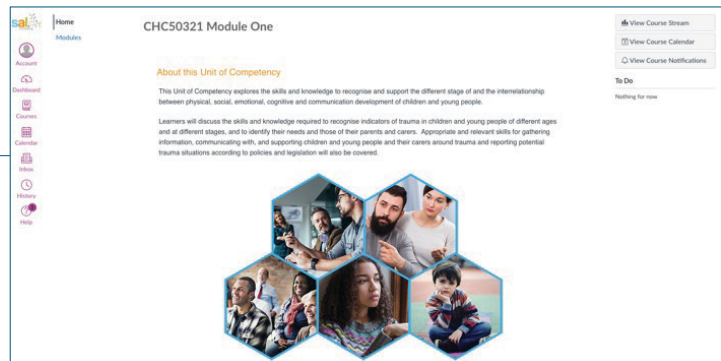
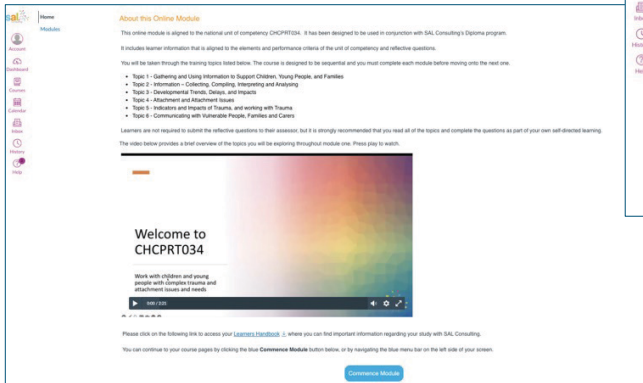
Our assessors are all Zoom experts so you will still get a face-to-face experience wherever you are!

Who will you be working with?

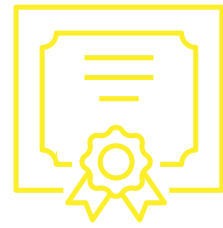
