

Proactive Approaches to Safe Incident Intervention

The course is delivered with a strong neurodevelopment and trauma informed focus.

The following topics will be covered:

- > Staff self-awareness and self-care
- A developmental context, including brain development
- Supporting people from culturally diverse backgrounds
- Trauma informed positive behaviour support
- Profiling
- Building capacity for people you work with
- Exploring client aggression
- Legal and ethical considerations

The final component of the course focuses on the safe physical intervention moves. This section will also discuss the legal and ethical considerations for managing behaviours of concern.

The physical intervention moves highlight:

- Evasions
- Deflections
- Releases
